She has been former senator and Deputy President of the People's Party Group in the Spanish Senate (1986-1989), she has been Member of Parliament in the Spanish Congress (1989-1996). Former Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food (1996-1999) and former Vice President of the European Commission (1999-2004), she has been Commissioner for Transport, Energy and Relations with the European Parliament (1999-2004). Currently she chairs the Foreign Policy Council of the People's Party in Spain and the High Level Group on the Pan-European Mediterranean Transport Network. She is also Guest Professor at the European University Institute, San Domenico di Fiesole. She is member of Jacques Delors Institute's Board of Directors.
