Tomorrow's Europe - The first ever Pan-EU Deliberative Poll® > Putting all of Europe in one room


Imagine all of Europe in one room discussing economic and social policies at the heart of the future of the European Union--to what degree can they talk to each other and understand each other's concerns? Tomorrow's Europe will attempt to answer these questions, seeing what the difference in opinion would be between an informed and uninformed public.

This "pan-European Deliberative Poll" focusing on economic and social policies issues will call into being, for the first time ever, a European wide "public sphere" in which the members of each country discuss Europe, not just with other citizens of the same country, but in a dialogue that is truly European wide.

- Because this will be a scientific sample, it will be truly representative of the mass citizenry.
- Because there will be serious and balanced deliberations, it will truly represent what European wide public opinion would be like if people had an opportunity to think about it under good conditions.
- Because it is organised a few days ahead of a European Summit in June that will be crucial for determining the EU's agenda in forthcoming years, it will bring real added value to EU decision makers and to the media.

To date, DPs have been held successfully in over 25 countries, but never on an international scale.
