Alternatively, use the train lines RE3 or RE5 to Potsdamer Platz. From there it takes a 5 minute walk through the Leipziger Str. to the main entrance of the Federal Ministry of Finance in the Wilhelmstraße 97.

Arrival by train

From Airport Berlin-Tegel (TXL) take the Bus X9 (direction: Zoologischer Garten) until U-Bhf Ernst-Reuter-Platz. From there, take the underground line U2 (direction: Pankow) to Potsdamer Platz. From there it takes a 5 minute walk through the Leipziger Str. to the main entrance of the Federal Ministry of Finance in the Wilhelmstr. 97.

From Airport Berlin-Schönefeld use the S9 (direction: Spandau) to Alexander-platz. From Alexanderplatz you can use the bus M48 to get to Leipziger Straße or the underground U2 (direction: Ruhleben) to Potsdamer Platz. In both cases, it takes a 5 minute walk through the Leipziger Str. to the main entrance of the Federal Ministry of Finance in the Wilhelmstr. 97.
