

# Internship Vacancy – Research Assistant On European Governance And International Relations

Six months starting in March 2023

[The Jacques Delors Institute](#) (JDI) is looking for a research assistant on European governance and international relations for a six-month internship starting in March 2023. The assistance will provide support to various research activities and events conducted as part of a three-year Horizon Europe project (REGROUP) on the effects of the Covid-19 pandemic and other crises on national, EU and global governance. This includes preparatory work for two research papers as well as support for the planning, implementation and analysis of a so-called mini-public.

The candidate should have:

- A Master's degree in law, political science, economics or international relations
- Excellent knowledge of EU policies and institutions
- Good knowledge of global governance and international organisations
- Interest and (ideally) work or research experience on the topics of trust and disinformation in politics
- Excellent command of English and French
- Good writing and communication skills and an ability to work autonomously
- Previous experience in academic research will be highly appreciated.

His/her main tasks will be:

- Provide support for research on the performance of global governance structures and instruments in response to the Covid-19 pandemic and to other global crises (in particular the 2007-08 financial crisis and the ongoing climate emergency)
- Provide support for research on the impact of the Covid pandemic and other crises on European integration
- Help JDI researchers plan, implement and analyse the results of a mini-public on the topics of trust and disinformation in politics. A mini-public is an exercise in deliberative democracy based on citizen input. Tasks may include the preparation of background materials for the meetings as well as the transcription and translation (from French to English) of the discussions.
- Assist in the organisation of other events and research activities conducted by the Jacques Delors Institute.
